- clear glass bottles & jars
- brown glass bottles & jars
- green glass bottles & jars
- No. 1 & 2 plastic bottles & jugs
- office paper
- magazines
- newspaper
- corrugated cardboard
- junk mail
- aluminum cans
- tin cans

### 6<sup>th</sup> Household Hazardous Waste Collection Event

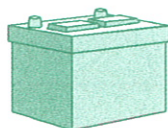
Mark your calendars! Friday, August 12<sup>th</sup> from 2pm to 6pm and Saturday August 13<sup>th</sup> from 9am to 2pm, the Authority will be holding its 6<sup>th</sup> Household Hazardous Waste Collection Event for Clinton County residents. The following materials will be accepted:

- pesticides
- herbicides
- fertilizers
- garden chemicals
- brake fluid
- cleaners
- bleach/pool chemicals
- spot removers
- paint remover
- aerosol cans
- drain cleaners
- propane tanks
- motor oil
- rechargeable batteries
- auto batteries
- antifreeze

**Please note: LATEX or OIL BASED PAINTS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.**

If you have latex/oil based paint, please use sawdust or kitty litter to absorb the liquid, allow to dry, then put it out with your regular garbage. Please call with questions regarding this event. You may also visit our web site for ways to handle paint.

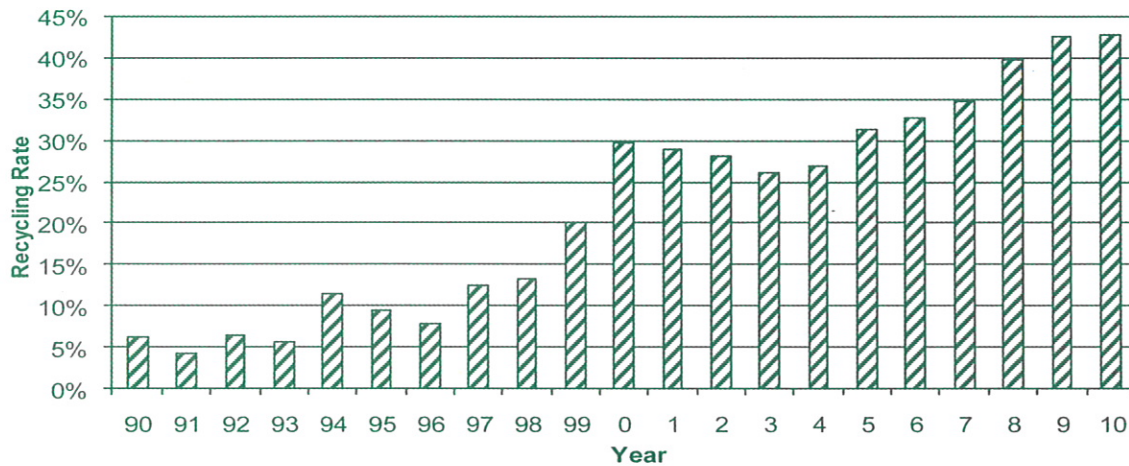
## 2010 Clinton County Recycling Statistics

Every year the Clinton County Solid Waste Authority collects recycling data from businesses, industries, and institutions throughout Clinton County. This information is then added to the recycling data from the Authority's countywide recycling program, resulting in a "County" recycling rate. During 2010 almost 18,000 tons of various types of materials were recycled. This number can be broken down into three major categories:

1. Curbside Recycling: 891 tons
2. Drop-Off Recycling: 3,537 tons
3. Business, Industrial, and Institutional Recycling: 13,482 tons

When comparing the 18,000 tons of recyclables to the amount of municipal solid waste generated in the county, a recycling rate of 42.7% was achieved. As shown on the chart below, recycling in Clinton County is certainly going in the right direction!

### Curbside Recycling

Have you considered the convenience of curbside recycling? The Solid Waste Authority will stop by your home every two (2) weeks and pick up your recyclables for a nominal annual fee of \$30 (\$2.50 per month). The materials we collect include: aluminum & tin cans, clear/brown/green glass bottles & jars, newspaper, magazines, junk mail, and No. 1 & No. 2 plastic bottles.

(The Authority is under contract with the City of Lock Haven to provide this service to city residents. If you live in the City, please continue to put your recyclables out on your curbside on the regularly scheduled dates.)

## Clinton County Recycling Directions

The following materials are collected and recycled in Clinton County: clear, green, and brown glass bottles & jars; newspaper; mixed paper; corrugated cardboard; aluminum, steel, and tin cans; and plastic bottles. The materials are collected by our curbside collection or drop-off collection programs. The table below identifies the materials and how to prepare them for recycling.

Please follow these directions and the directions posted at each drop-off site. If an item you have is not on this list dispose of it properly. If you are not sure please call us at 570-769-6977.

MATERIAL	WHAT CAN BE RECYCLED	HOW TO PREPARE FOR RECYCLING	WHAT CAN'T BE RECYCLED
<b>Glass Bottles &amp; Jars</b>	Clear, brown, and green glass bottles & jars.	Rinse containers, remove lids, leave labels on.	Window glass, light bulbs, crystal, Pyrex, ceramics, ovenware, & drinking glasses.
<b>Newspaper</b>	Clean Newspaper (including inserts).	Separate from mixed paper.	Phone books.
<b>Mixed Paper</b>	Office paper, junk mail, magazines, catalogs, glossy paper.	Separate from newspaper.	Phone books, coated paper, tissue paper, hard-backed books.
<b>Corrugated Cardboard</b>	Clean <u>corrugated</u> cardboard.	Breakdown boxes.	Cereal boxes, six-pack carriers, waxed cardboard.
<b>Cans</b>	Aluminum, steel, & tin food and beverage cans.	Rinse containers, leave labels on.	Pie plates, aluminum foil, pesticide or herbicide spray cans.
<b>Plastic Bottles &amp; Jugs</b>	Plastic bottles, coded #1 or #2, typically soda, milk, water, & laundry soap bottles.	Rinse containers, remove lids, leave labels on.	Toys, plastic bottles coded #3 thru #7, motor oil bottles, other plastic containers.

### COLLECTION INSTRUCTIONS

- Please rinse all containers and remove lids.
- Place newspaper and magazines/junk mail into **separate** plastic bags.
- Place at curbside by **7:00am** on day of scheduled pick up.
- If your collection day falls on a holiday your pickup will be the **next business day**.

## Commercial/Industrial Recycling in Clinton County

Do you have a commercial or industrial establishment located in Clinton County? If so, then you maybe eligible to participate in our Commercial Recycling Program. The Authority has a flexible and cost effective recycling program to meet the needs of your establishment. These types of establishments located within the City of Lock Haven are required by state law and city ordinance to recycle, at a minimum, high-grade office paper, corrugated cardboard, aluminum, clear/colored glass and steel/bi-metal cans. The Authority can help design a recycling program to satisfy these requirements. We currently offer three commercial recycling options:

- 68 gallon wheeled carts, serviced weekly.
- 68 gallon wheeled carts, serviced bi-weekly.
- Blue Box, serviced bi-weekly.

Our commercial recycling carts are made to accommodate your recycling needs. If you need assistance in determining what your recycling needs are and how we can help you please give us a call.

### Facts about our Commercial Carts:

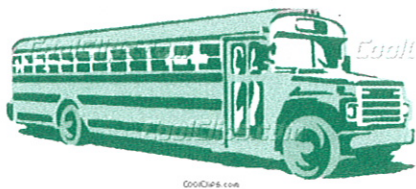
- The carts are easily moved when full.
- Each cart is labeled for each of your recycling items.
- Weekly pickup is \$120.00 per year or \$10.00/month.
- Bi-weekly pickup is \$60.00 per year or \$5.00/month.
- Bi-weekly pickup is \$30.00 per year or \$2.50/month.



### Education! Education! Education!

With the onset of spring and the end of the school year many teachers are trying to get their students out to see and learn hands on about the subjects they have been teaching all year. Many of these students come to the Wayne Township Landfill, where we teach them that we are more than just a dump! Students from pre-school through college, as well as adult groups have taken the 2 hour tour here at the landfill. They have learned how we place waste in the landfill, the different materials we recycle, how we conserve natural resources and try our best to be environmentally friendly, while using innovative technologies to enhance the way we handle waste and recycling.

Since 2004, more than 2500 students and adults have either been on a tour or seen a presentation on the Wayne Township Landfill. Everyone always leaves surprised that we are NOT JUST A DUMP! ### Brush & Yard Waste

If you have brush and yard waste, excluding grass clippings, the Authority would like to suggest that you recycle this material at our mulch facility. There is no charge for dropping off your brush and yard waste at the landfill. We ask residents to stop at the office and sign in so we know you are on site and then sign out before you leave. There is no need to come across the scales.

### Clinton County Residential Tire Collection Event

On Friday, May 13<sup>th</sup> from 8 am to 4 pm and Saturday, May 14<sup>th</sup> from 8 am to 12 pm the Authority held another Tire Collection Event.

The event was very successful. Residents from 24 of 29 municipalities participated and more than 225 vehicles participated. The event collected 3,163 tires, bringing the total number of tires collected since 2003 to nearly 50,000 tires!
