Recycling Opportunities Lock Haven Residents



The City of Lock Haven provides free curbside recycling for all city resi-

Materials should be placed in the green recycling bins, which should be placed at the curb by 7:00 a.m. on the day of your scheduled pick-up. Collection days are scheduled according to the recycling zone you live in. You may contact the City to get a refrigerator magnet with the collection schedule. If your collection day falls on a major holiday, your recycling will be picked up on the next business day.

When you have more recyclables than will fit in the green curbside bin, you may use another container, but the container should be clearly marked "Recycling" so the collection crew will know it contains recyclables.

The materials collected at the curb include: aluminum & tin cans, newspaper, magazines, junk mail, paperboard (cereal boxes, six pack holders, etc.) and plastic containers, coded #1 thru #7 (1 gallon or smaller).

The City also provides a recycling drop-off site at the corner of East Park and Myrtle Street for the convenience of City Residents. In addition to the materials collected at the curb, corrugated cardboard is also collected at the drop-off site. Please remember to breakdown your boxes and remove any "non-corrugated cardboard" material from inside the box.

City commercial establishments and multi-family dwellings (4 units or more) are required by state law and city ordinance to recycle a minimum of three of the listed materials. Contact the City or the Wayne Township Landfill for assistance with your commercial recycling program.

In an effort to reduce waste going into the landfill and to promote recycling, the Wayne Township Landfill is accepting clean wood waste free of charge. Examples of what qualifies as wood waste is brush and yard waste, logs, untreated construction lumber, wood pallets, wood chips, stumps or cleanup projects such as land clearing waste. This is a waste that can create a problem on your site, causing all sorts of issues from blocked access points to trip hazards or unsightly piles for years to come. Even if it is just a big pile that you see in your daily travels, we would be interested in assisting to remove it.

When you bring us your wood waste, we are partnering together in a sustainable green recycling partnership. All the incoming material that we receive from our customers is being recycled into an efficient, clean product such as a high quality mulch product, sawdust material, or compost material. We also offer hauling and loading services for these piles and can help get them cleaned up, resolving your wood waste dilemma and boosting recycling of these products. The Wayne Township Landfill is also available to assist businesses and industries with their solid waste management decisions. Your Holiday Recycling Checklist!

√ Deliver my real Christmas tree free of charge to the landfill. Remember to remove any trimmings and tinsel!!!

- √ Place my used holiday cards and **non-metallic** wrapping paper in the junk mail/office paper compartment at a local recycling drop off site or for curbside pick up.
- √ Take my corrugated cardboard boxes, which I broke down or flattened, to a local recycling drop-off site.

Curbside Recycling Application

Have you considered the convenience of curbside recycling? The Authority will stop by your home every two (2) weeks and pick up your recyclables for a nominal **annual fee of \$42** (\$3.50 per month). The materials we collect include: aluminum & tin cans, newspaper, magazines, junk mail, paperboard and plastic containers (< 1 gallon in size). (The Authority is under contract with the City of Lock Haven to provide this service to city residents. If you live in the City, please continue to put your recyclables out on your curbside on the regularly scheduled dates. If you need a collection bin, call City Hall at 570-893-5900.)
