RECYCLE RIGHT CLINTON COUNTY - The sustainability of our recycling program is dependent on collecting high quality materials without unacceptable materials or trash. We need your help, please do your part!

Residential Battery Recycling Program



The Wayne Township Landfill (WTL) is now accepting rechargeable and single-use batteries, in addition to leadacid vehicle batteries, at our recycling facility in Wayne Township. Our goal is to provide a system to help keep batteries out of the trash, which in turn helps to minimize the potential for fires in trash trucks and the landfill. This is a free service to residents of Clinton County. Businesses are not eligible to use this program.

See below for instructions on how to prepare your batteries:

- Place each individual battery in a small plastic bag. We do not accept multiple batteries in one plastic bag.
- You may also use black electrical tape, duct tape or packaging tape to cover the ends of the battery with the terminal. Do not use masking tape, scotch tape, or painter's tape.
- Electric vehicle or EV batteries and electric bike or e-bike batteries are NOT included in this recycling program.

Residential batteries can be dropped off during normal business hours, Monday thru Friday 7:00 am to 4:00 pm and Saturday 7:00 am to 12 Noon, at the WTL recycling center located at 337 Pine Mountain Road, just past the Restless Oaks Restaurant.



Glass Bottle & Jar Recycling

The WTL is accepting glass bottles and jars at the WTL recycling facility in Wayne Township. Glass bottles and jars can be dropped off during normal business hours, Monday - Friday 7:00 am to 4:00 pm and Saturday 7:00 am to 12:00 pm. Glass bottles & jars are <u>not</u> accepted at the curb or the other county recycling drop-off sites.

NO GLASSWARE, CERAMICS, WINDOW GLASS, LIGHT BULBS, WINDSHIELDS, PYREX, OR SIMILAR ITEMS ARE ACCEPTED!

Curbside Recycling Changes



In an effort to make our curbside recycling program more sustainable some of our collection routes have been consolidated or eliminated. In addition, the annual fee for this service has been increased from \$72.00 to \$84.00. All current curbside customers have been notified of these changes. Curbside collection routes within the City of Lock Haven are not affected by these changes. Please feel free to contact us with any questions.

Manure & Leaf Compost at WTL!

Compost is the safest way to boost the integrity of your soil for growing plants, whether it be grass, vegetables or flowers. WTL offers 2 types of compost, Manure Compost and Leaf Compost. Each type of compost starts out with approximately 60% decomposed landscape mulch and then 40% of either manure or leaves is added. Each type of compost goes through multiple heat cycles until the compost reaches ~140° F for 3 consecutive days. These heat cycles ensure that mold, fungi, spores, and insects are eliminated. Compost builds healthy soil, increases organic content, helps to prevent soil erosion, conserves water and improves plant growth in your gardens. Be sure to stop in and get your garden a boost! We are also able to deliver this material.

Attention Horse Owners: The WTL is actively seeking horse manure to start next year's manure compost. We accept the manure at no charge. If you do not have a way to bring it to our facility, contact us and we will gladly make arrangements to pick it up (you load) for a nominal charge.

Christmas Trees & Wrapping Paper



We are encouraging everyone to gather up their wrapping paper (no foil paper), paperboard and holiday cards for recycling. These items can be dropped off at any of our local recycling drop-off locations. They can be placed in the bin with office paper and junk mail. We can also accept your cardboard boxes at these locations.

During Christmas residents enjoy having a real tree in the house. These trees can be recycled. To recycle your tree you come in to the mulch facility and drop it at the brush and yard waste pile and the best part is that it is free of charge. All trees are ground and eventually made into landscape mulch.

Recycling Opportunities for Lock Haven Residents and Commercial Establishments

The City of Lock Haven provides free curbside recycling for all city residents. Materials should be placed in the green recycling bins, which should be placed at the curb by 7:00 a.m. on the day of your scheduled pick-up. Collection days are scheduled according to the recycling zone you live in. You may contact the City to get a refrigerator magnet with the collection schedule. If your collection day falls on a major holiday, your recycling will be picked up on the next business day.

When you have more recyclables than will fit in the green curbside bin, you may use another container, but the container should be clearly marked "Recycling" so the collection crew will know it contains recyclables.

The materials collected at the curb include: aluminum, steel & tin cans, newspaper, magazines, junk mail, paperboard (cereal boxes, six pack holders, etc.) and plastic bottles & jugs.

The City also provides a recycling drop-off site at the corner of East Park and Myrtle Street for the convenience of City Residents. In addition to the materials collected at the curb, corrugated cardboard is also collected at the drop-off site. Please remember to breakdown your boxes and remove any "non-corrugated cardboard" material from inside the box.

City commercial establishments and multi-family dwellings (4 units or more) are required by state law and city ordinance to recycle a minimum of three of the listed materials. Contact the City or the Wayne Township Landfill for assistance with your commercial recycling program. If you need a recycling bin, a collection schedule, or have questions regarding recycling in the City, please contact City Hall at 570-893-5612 or visit the City's website at www.lockhavenpa.gov.

Other Important News!!!

- ♦ The cost for using WTL Self-Dump is \$30 for a single load and \$50 for a double or oversize load. Please remember to tarp and secure your load.
- ♦ Are you ready for some DIY landscaping? Our #1 regular mulch is \$25 per yard. Want a little color in your yard? Choose dyed black or brown mulch for \$32 per yard. Call our office for delivery options.
- ♦ We accept tires at the landfill everyday. The cost is \$3.00 per car/light truck tire for Clinton County residents.
- City of Lock haven has an ordinance which requires all commercial entities to recycle at least 3 materials. Please contact us to get set up. We have a program to fit your budget.

- ♦ Educational Tours for all ages are available by appointment. Please call 570-769-6977 to schedule a tour.
- Clinton County residents with appliances containing Freon can bring them to WTL free of charge.

Curbside Recycling: An Overview



Below you will find a table that describes what we collect via our curbside recycling program. The table also outlines how to prepare the material for recycling and what materials are not accepted. Newspaper	Clean newspaper (including inserts).	Separate from mixed paper.	Wet or dirty newspaper.	
Mixed Paper	Office paper, junk mail, phone books, magazines, catalogs, glossy paper.	Separate from newspaper.	Laminated or coated paper, tissue paper and paper towels.	
Paperboard	Clean food boxes, paper towel rolls, shoe boxes, tissue boxes.	Include with mixed paper.	Milk cartons, juice cartons, ice cream containers and similar materials.	
Cans	Aluminum, steel, & tin food and beverage cans.	Rinse, leave labels on. Pie plates, aluminum foil, pesticide herbicide spray cans.		
Plastic Bottles & Jugs - ONLY	Plastic bottles & jugs, coded #1 - #7	Rinse, remove lids, leave labels on.	Toys, motor oil or chemical bottles.	

Curbside Recycling Collection Notes:

- Recycling material should be placed at the curb by 7:00 am on the day of your scheduled pick-up.
- ♦ If you put out more recycling than fits in your blue or green recycling bin, please mark it "Recycling".
- If your pick-up day falls on a major holiday, your recycling material will be picked up on the next business day.

Curbside Recycling Application

Have you considered the convenience of curbside recycling? The Authority will stop by your home every two (2) weeks and pick up your recyclables for a nominal **annual fee of \$84** (\$7.00 per month). Annual fee will be prorated based on service start time.

The materials we collect include: aluminum & tin cans, newspaper, magazines, junk mail, paperboard and plastic bottles & jugs. (The Authority is under contract with the City of Lock Haven to provide this service to city residents. If you live in the City, please continue to put your recyclables out on your curbside on the regularly scheduled dates. If you need a recycling bin, call City Hall at 570-893-5900.)

- Labels are acceptable
- Place in properly labeled cart



MIXED PAPERS, JUNK MAIL, MAGAZINES, PAPERBOARD, AND NEWSPAPERS



- All mixed papers, junk mail, magazines catalogs, and paperboard are acceptable
- DRY papers only
- No laminated or oily paperboard
- Place inside properly labeled cart





CORRUGATED CARDBOARD

- Flatten ALL boxes
- Place flattened boxes alongside carts or in provided dumpsters



PLASTIC BOTTLES AND JUGS

- #1-#7 plastic bottles and jugs ONLY
- Rinse containers
- Labels are acceptable
- Remove lids and caps
- Place in properly labeled container

- All mixed papers, junk mail, magazines, catalogs, and paperboard are acceptable
- DRY papers only
- No laminated or oily paperboard
- Keep newspaper separated





PLASTIC BOTTLES AND JUGS

- #1-#7 plastic bottles and jugs ONLY
- Rinse containers
- Labels are acceptable
- Remove lids and caps
