Plastic Bottle Recycling

The Solid Waste Authority would like to take this opportunity to remind residents about which plastics we recycle. We only accept #1 and #2 plastic **bottles** and **jugs**. Please follow the guide below:

These are examples of the items which **ARE** acceptable:

- Milk Jugs
- Water Bottles
- · Laundry and Dish Soap Bottles
- Soda Bottles







These are examples of the items which ARE NOT acceptable:

- Plastic tubs (margarine tubs)
- Yogurt containers
- Plastic toys
- Motor oil bottles
- TV dinner dishes







Wayne Township Landfill Update

Planning for the future of Clinton County's solid waste needs is a large part of what the Solid Waste Authority works towards on a daily basis. Trying to accomplish this, while being competitive in the solid waste industry, is a difficult task. We are currently 5+ years into the re-permitting process of our closed landfill located within our current property boundary in Wayne Township.

The project will entail removing the trash from the unlined landfill and installing a state of the art liner system, similar to what has been constructed for our active landfill. Redevelopment of the closed landfill will create approximately 30 more years of disposal capacity to meet the area's solid waste needs. The actual permit application was submitted to the PaDEP in November 2007. The PaDEP is currently in the technical review phase of their review. We are anticipating that this process will be completed and the new permit will be issued by the end of the summer.

Due to the increase in the volume of waste from the natural gas industry a second scale system was installed and placed into service on May 12, 2010. The second scale system will allow us to keep inbound and outbound traffic moving, thus minimizing the time in line waiting to be weighed. Reminder - mulch customers do not need to come across the scales.

We will keep the community updated as we progress in our mission to continue to be the long-term economical solution to the area's waste needs. Throughout this process, and in our everyday operations, we will stick to our motto:


Clinton County Recycling on the Rise!

Every year the Clinton County Solid Waste Authority collects recycling data from businesses, industries, and institutions throughout Clinton County. This information is then added to the recycling data from the Authority's countywide recycling program, resulting in a "County" recycling rate. During 2009 over 17,000 tons of various types of materials were recycled. This number can be broken down into three major categories:

Curbside Recycling: 895 tons
 Drop-Off Recycling: 4,707 tons

3. Business, Industrial, and Institutional Recycling: 11,673 tons

When comparing the 17,000 tons of recyclables to the amount of municipal solid waste generated in the county, a recycling rate of 42.4% was achieved. As shown on the chart below, recycling in Clinton County is certainly on the rise!



Curbside Recycling

Have you considered the convenience of curbside recycling? The Solid Waste Authority will stop by your home every two (2) weeks and pick up your recyclables for a nominal annual fee of \$30 (\$2.50 per month). The materials we collect include: aluminum & tin cans, clear/brown/green glass bottles & jars, newspaper, magazines, junk mail, and No. 1 & No. 2 plastic bottles.

(The Authority is under contract with the City of Lock Haven to provide this service to city residents. If you live in the City, please continue to put your recyclables out on your curbside on the regularly scheduled dates.)

Brush & Yard Waste

With the change of seasons everyone is cleaning up from the winter and that means yard work. If you have brush and yard waste excluding grass clippings, the Authority would like to suggest that you recycle this material at our mulch facility. There is no charge for dropping your brush and yard waste at the landfill. We ask residents to stop at the office and sign in so we know you are on site and then sign out before you leave. There is no need to come across the scales.

And for your one stop shopping needs you can pick up a load of mulch from the mulch facility on your way out. This year we have two types of double ground mulch products, natural and colored. Our natural mulch (#1) for \$16.00 per cubic yard and our colored (red, dark brown and black) mulch is sold for \$25.00 per cubic yard. We can also deliver mulch to your location, for a nominal fee.

Commercial Recycling

The Authority has developed a flexible and cost effective recycling program to meet the needs of commercial and institutional establishments within the county. These types of establishments located within the City of Lock Haven are required by state law and city ordinance to recycle, at a minimum high-grade office paper corrugated cardboard.

minimum, high-grade office paper, corrugated cardboard, aluminum, clear/colored glass and steel/bi-metal cans. The Authority can help design a recycling program to satisfy these requirements.

- **Mulch** The Wayne Township Landfill continues to sell landscape mulch. Wayne Township Residents are allowed to receive up to 10 yards free with proof of residency.

Clinton County Residential Tire Collection Event

On Friday, May 21st from 8 am to 4 pm and Saturday, May 22nd from 8 am to 12 pm the Authority held another Tire Collection Event.

The event was very successful. Residents from 25 of 29 municipalities participated and more than 300 vehicles participated. The event collected 5,145 tires, bringing the total number of tires collected since 2003 to over 46,000!

It is better for the environment if you dispose of tires on a regular basis. The price to dispose of tires at the landfill if you are a Clinton County resident is \$120.00 per ton for a load of tires only. If tires are mixed with regular waste then an additional charge of \$2.00 per tire and \$5.00 per tire for large truck or tractor tires (greater than 17") is added. Residents outside of Clinton County will need to inquire about our daily tire prices. Please feel free to contact us for more information regarding tire disposal.

Electronics Recycling Program



The Authority would like to remind residents and businesses that we operate an Electronics Recycling Program during regular business hours (Monday through Friday, 8am to 4pm and Saturday's 8am to 12pm). The materials that are acceptable include: Computers, printers, scanners, telephones, cell phones, answering

machines, fax machines, copiers, televisions, VCR's, CD and DVD players, radios, stereos, video game consoles, cameras, calculators, adding machines, and audio visual equipment. Microwave ovens are not accepted and must be disposed of in the landfill.

Since September 2004, we have collected and recycled over 300 tons of electronics. Please deliver your electronics to the Recycling Center on Pine Mountain Road, the boxes for electronics are located just inside the door of the building. If you need help please ring the buzzer and one of our employees will gladly assist you with unloading your material.

The following materials are collected and recycled in Clinton County: clear, green, and brown glass bottles & jars; newspaper; mixed paper; corrugated cardboard; aluminum, steel, and tin cans; and plastic bottles. The materials are collected by our curbside collection or drop-off collection programs. The table below identifies the materials and how to prepare them for recycling.

Please follow these directions and the directions posted at each drop-off site. If an item you have is not on this list dispose of it properly. If you are not sure please call us at 570-769-6977.

Newspaper	Clean Newspaper (including inserts).	Separate from mixed paper.	Phone books.
Mixed Paper	Office paper, junk mail, magazines, catalogs, glossy paper.	Separate from newspaper.	Phone books, coated paper, tissue paper, hard-backed books.
Corrugated Cardboard	Clean corrugated cardboard.	Breakdown boxes.	Cereal boxes, six-pack carriers, waxed cardboard.
Cans	Aluminum, steel, & tin food and beverage cans.	Rinse containers, leave labels on.	Pie plates, aluminum foil, pesticide or herbicide spray cans.
Plastic Bottles & Jugs	Plastic bottles, coded #1 or #2, typically soda, milk, water, & laundry soap bottles.	Rinse containers, remove lids, leave labels on.	Toys, plastic bottles coded #3 thru #7, motor oil bottles, other plastic containers.

COLLECTION INSTRUCTIONS

- Please rinse all containers and remove lids.
- Place newspaper and magazines/junk mail into separate plastic bags.
- Place at curbside by 7:00am on day of scheduled pick up.
- If your collection day falls on a holiday your pickup will be the **next business day**.
