# **Coronavirus (COVID-19)**

With the return of residential curbside recycling on May 18<sup>th</sup>, the Wayne Township Landfill is back to full operation in regard to the services we provide. Currently, mulch transactions are now taking place at the Authority's administration building, just follow the signs. All customers must wear face masks in accordance with the PA Department of Health's Order.

# **Recycling Opportunities for Lock Haven Residents**

The City of Lock Haven provides free curbside recycling for all city residents. Materials should be placed in the green recycling bins, which should be placed at the curb by 7:00 a.m. on the day of your scheduled pick-up. Collection days are scheduled according to the recycling zone you live in. You may contact the City to get a refrigerator magnet with the collection schedule. If your collection day falls on a major holiday, your recycling will be picked up on the next business day.

When you have more recyclables than will fit in the green curbside bin, you may use another container, but the container should be clearly marked "Recycling" so the collection crew will know it contains recyclables.

The materials collected at the curb include: aluminum, steel & tin cans, newspaper, magazines, junk mail, paperboard (cereal boxes, six pack holders, etc.) and plastic bottles & jugs.

The City also provides a recycling drop-off site at the corner of East Park and Myrtle Street for the convenience of City Residents. In addition to the materials collected at the curb, corrugated cardboard is also collected at the drop-off site. Please remember to breakdown your boxes and remove any "non-corrugated cardboard" material from inside the box.

City commercial establishments and multi-family dwellings (4 units or more) are required by state law and city ordinance to recycle a minimum of three of the listed materials. Contact the City or the Wayne Township Landfill for assistance with your commercial recycling program.

# Curbside Recycling: An Overview



Below you will find a table that describes what we collect via our curbside recycling program. The table also outlines how to prepare the material for recycling and what materials are not accepted. MATERIAL	WHAT CAN BE RECYCLED	HOW TO PREPARE FOR RECYCLING	WHAT CAN'T BE RECYCLED
Newspaper	Clean newspaper (including in- serts).	Separate from mixed paper.	Wet or dirty newspaper.
Mixed Paper	Office paper, junk mail, phone books, magazines, catalogs, glossy paper.	Separate from newspaper.	Laminated or coated paper, tissue paper and paper towels.
Paperboard	Clean food boxes, paper towel rolls, shoe boxes, tissue boxes.	Include with mixed paper.	Milk cartons, juice cartons, ice cream containers and similar materials.
Cans	Aluminum, steel, & tin food and beverage cans.	Rinse, leave labels on.	Pie plates, aluminum foil, pesticide or herbicide spray cans.
Plastic Bottles & Jugs	Plastic bottles & jugs, coded #1 - #7	Rinse, remove lids, leave labels on.	Toys, motor oil or chemical bottles.

#### **Curbside Recycling Collection Notes:**

- Recycling material should be placed at the curb by 7:00 am on the day of your scheduled pick-up.
- If you put out more recycling than fits in your blue or green recycling bin, please mark it "Recycling".
- If your pick-up day falls on a major holiday, your recycling material will be picked up on the next business day.

#### **Curbside Recycling Application**

Have you considered the convenience of curbside recycling? The Authority will stop by your home every two (2) weeks and pick up your recyclables for a nominal **annual fee of \$51** (\$4.25 per month). The materials we collect include: aluminum & tin cans, news-paper, magazines, junk mail, paperboard and plastic bottles & jugs. (The Authority is under contract with the City of Lock Haven to provide this service to city residents. If you live in the City, please continue to put your recyclables out on your curbside on the regularly scheduled dates. If you need a collection box, call City Hall at 570-893-5900.)

## **Other Important News!!!**

- Clinton County residents and businesses may bring clean wood waste, brush & yard waste to our mulch facility free of charge. This material cannot be painted, stained, or treated. If placed in bags, the material must be removed from the bags and the bags can be thrown in the trailer at the self-dump. There is a charge of \$15.00 per ton for tree stumps.
- The cost for using WTL Self-Dump is \$20 for a single load and \$33 for a double or oversize load.
